ANOTHER ADVANCE
PENN. CRUDE OIL

PITTSBURGH, Oct. 4.—Another advance in the price of Pennsylvania crude oil was announced here today by the principal purchasing agencies, the second within a week. The new price of \$2.75 a barrel, an increase of 25 cents. The other grades were advanced twenty cents with the exception of Ragland, which remained unchanged as follows: Corning \$1.65; Cabell \$1.61; Somerset \$1.40; Somerset light \$1.65.
