

EXPECT OLSEN TO ARRIVE TOMORROW FOR THYE MATCH

Thor Olsen will arrive tomorrow for his match next Friday night at the Nat with Ted Thye, and the winner will meet the winner of the Hand-Miller match at Gold Hill next Tuesday, October 18th. These two contests will give valley wrestling fans two good, rip-roaring bouts in seven days, with more in prospect.

Pupils of Charles Melrose will give exhibitions of wrestling before the main event of the show at the Nat, and they will illustrate the holds that are barred. The main event will start at nine o'clock. Melrose will act as referee. He is a wrestler himself, and knows the game, so there will be no aftermath discussion of what the referee should have done.

Gold Hill and adjacent country has started to boil over the match, and a record crowd will be on hand to see the match, which will be a hum-dinger.
