TAX ON FAT PEOPLE IS LATEST IN GERMANY

BERLIN.—The government's search for new sources of revenue to meet increasing expenditures has brought a group of humorists to the rescue, one branch of which, submitting a statute already prepared, suggests a tax on fat folks whose waist-line circumference exceeds the chest measurement.
