

FLAT CORPORATION TAX 15 PER CENT IS PASSED 26-36

WASHINGTON, Oct. 31.—By a vote of 36 to 26 the senate recently adopted a finance committee amendment providing for a flat corporation income tax of 15 per cent, effective next Jan. 1. The rate agreed upon by the public was 12 1/2 per cent.

Eight republicans voted against the committee amendment providing for the flat corporation tax and two democrats supported it. The republicans were Calder, Edge, Frellinghaysen, Johnson, LaFollette, McKinley, Moses and Norris.

The democrats were Reed and Kinn.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 31.—By a margin of one vote, the Walsh amendment proposing a graduated income tax on corporations was rejected recently by the senate. The vote was 32 to 22 with ten republicans standing with the solid democratic minority for the amendment.

The republicans were Senators Borah, Capper, Cummins, Kenyon, La Follette, Lenroot, McNary, Norbeck, Norris and Townsend. Before the vote was taken Senator Walsh, democrat, Massachusetts, amended his amendment so that the maximum tax to be paid by the corporations which did not pay excess profits last year would be at a flat ten per cent rate.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 31.—The way was paved Saturday by Senator Reed, democrat, Missouri, to force a vote on the soldier bonus bill, which the senate recently laid on the table at the request of President Harding.

Senator Reed introduced an amendment to the tax revision bill providing for taxes on excess profits of corporations and for use of the revenue derived as a special fund to pay bonuses to former service men. The amendment included the McCumber bonus bill, reported by the senate finance committee, providing for five way benefits to former service men.
