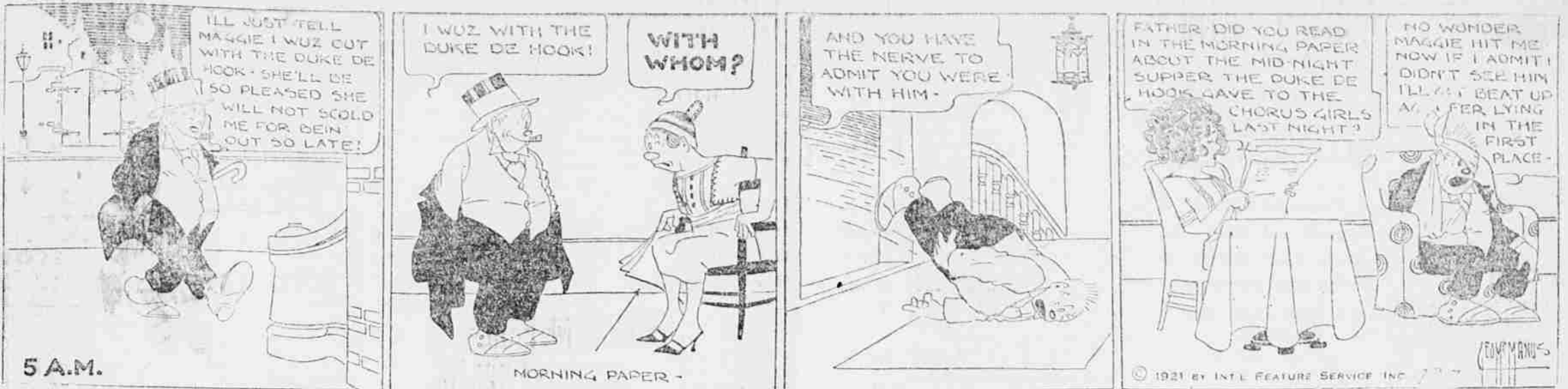

The number of injured has not been ascertained.
