

UNIFORM VEHICLE LAWS PROPOSED FOR TWO STATES

OLYMPIA, Wash., Dec. 8.—A meeting of officials of the Oregon and Washington traffic department here today resulted in the appointment of a committee to draw up recommendations relative to motor vehicle laws as applied between the two states, which can be submitted to the Oregon legislature this month and to the Washington legislature at its next session.

Discussion centered around the Oregon law which allows a person to operate a motor vehicle for ninety days without an Oregon license, and which officials contemplate asking the legislature to repeal. That no extra penalty should be assessed against corporations doing business in the two states was the consensus of opinion at the meeting. It being held that corporations should receive the same rights as individuals.

Those on the committee to work out a reciprocity plan are: T. A. Rafferty, chief field deputy in the Oregon department of state; Major Louis F. Lang, chief of the Washington highway patrol; O. R. Shuman, assistant attorney general of Washington.

IRISH POLITICAL PRISONERS FREED

BELFAST, Dec. 8.—(By the Associated Press.)—The 1,600 interned men in the Ballykinler camp were released today under the amnesty proclamation and left for their homes amid scenes of enthusiasm. Soldiers' songs were freely chorused and the car windows of the train bearing away the released men were ablaze with the Sinn Féin tricolor.

Diverse opinions were expressed by the men on the new turn of the Irish situation given by DeValera's statement on the treaty. The leader had many supporters, some of whom had fought with him in the Dublin rebellion, who declared their implicit confidence in him, while others expressed themselves strongly for the agreement.
