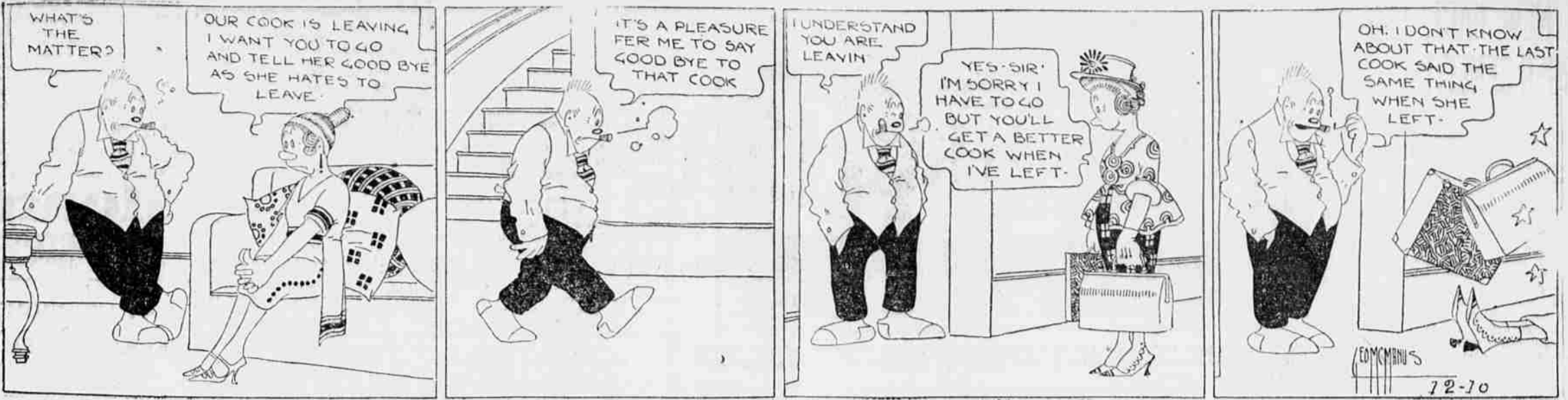


# BRINGING UP FATHER
