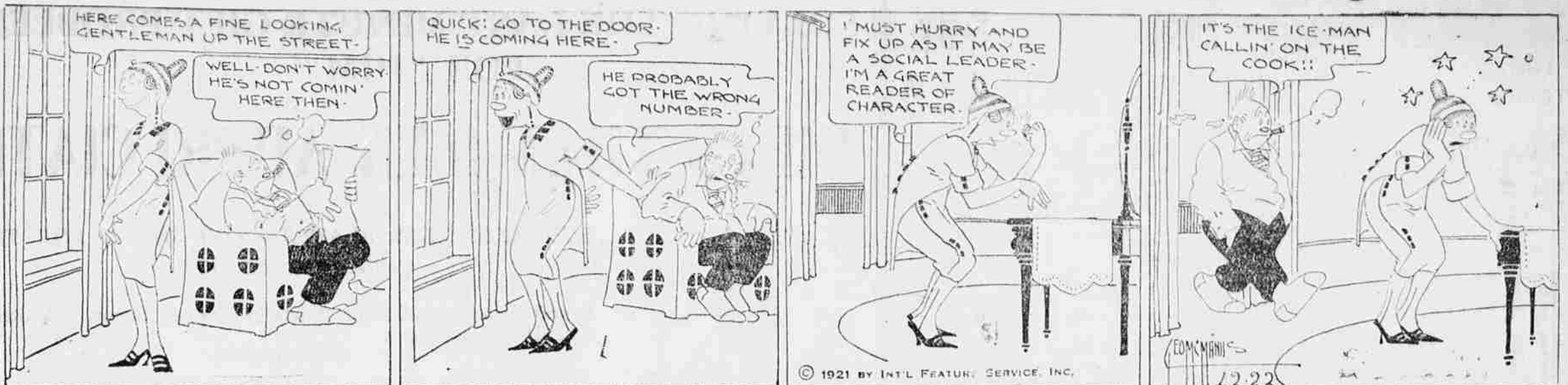

OFFICIALS DENY REPORT OF DEBS XMAS PARDON

ATLANTA, Ga., Dec. 22.—Officials at the federal penitentiary today declared no instructions had been received from the department of justice at Washington relative to the release of Eugene V. Debs, socialist leader, serving a ten year sentence for violation of war time laws.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 22.—The list of Christmas pardons to be issued tomorrow will be a subject of discussion between President Harding and Attorney General Daugherty at an after dinner conference tonight at the White House. The list is known to contain 197 names, among them a number of federal prisoners convicted of violations of war time laws.

TERRE HAUTE, Ind., Dec. 22.—Relatives of Eugene V. Debs today stated they had "reliable information" to the effect that Debs would reach Terre Haute Saturday evening from Atlanta penitentiary.
