

### BISHOP GRACE OF SACRAMENTO DIES, AGE 81

SACRAMENTO, Cal., Dec. 27.—Thomas Grace, for more than twenty-five years bishop of the Roman Catholic diocese of Sacramento, died here today after an illness of several months. He was 81 years of age.

Bishop Grace, who was prominent in the Catholic church of northern California and Nevada for more than half a century, was a great believer in the church. A son of James Grace, who was of Norman extraction and a descendant of the famous Raymond DeGres of the twelfth century, he was a native of Wexford, Ireland, being born in 1841.

A preliminary education was received in the schools in the vicinity of his home, after which he was given instruction at St. Peter's, Wexford, by Bishop Furlong. Later he became a student at All Hallows college, Dublin, and in that city was ordained to the priesthood in 1867.

In September of 1867 he came to California and soon took charge of the parish at Red Bluff, Tehama county. During his pastorage he built the convent of Mercy.

In 1870 he removed to Grass Valley and remained there until 1874, going then to Marysville. In 1881 he came to Sacramento and assumed charge of the parish of St. Rose's church and remained as such until he became bishop in 1907.

Bishop Grace was responsible for the establishment of the Stanford orphan home for friendless children here.

Mrs. Jane Stanford deeded to Bishop Grace the former Stanford mansion and four years later it was dedicated to the aid of friendless children.

### BOLSHVEIKI ARE NOW SCRAMBLING BACK TO CAPITAL

MOSCOW, Dec.—(By Associated Press.) The soviet government is devising all sorts of taxes in an effort to meet its expenses. It is reducing the number of employees and charging for everything which used to be free. A state bank has been opened to facilitate foreign trade. Bills of exchange will be handled. Deposits will be accepted and interest paid on them. Loans will also be made. The capital of the bank is 3,000,000,000 rubles and the total issue of paper money to date is said to 5,750,000,000 rubles.

The ruble continues to fall, and the government and public alike are scrambling all the time for foreign currency. Chicherin's offer to recognize the pre-war foreign debts if the soviet powers will grant soviet Russia recognition had no stabilizing effect on Bolshevist money.

The American relief administration child-feeding, and the announcement that warehouses will be established by the Hoover organization to supply food packages on drafts sent from abroad have not checked the rising price of bread and economists say it will continue to rise until the next harvest and the famine will be far worse next spring than it is now.

It is clear that the soviet government is returning to capitalism as rapidly as it can without losing its communistic support. But Lenin, Kalenin and other leaders frankly admit in their addresses that this is being done only after stores of manufactured articles and financial resources have been exhausted. They also say the change is being made merely to get a breathing spell for another attack on world capitalism.

### THEATRE OWNERS HELD GUILTY OF NINE DEATHS

NEW HAVEN, Dec. 27.—City Building Inspector Joseph E. Austin, Lawrence E. C. Carroll, manager of the Rialto theater, and Alfred R. Black, president of the Connecticut Theaters corporation which owned the theater, are held criminally responsible for the deaths of nine persons in the Rialto theater fire of November 27 in a finding of Coroner Eli Mix today.

The coroner says that the direct cause of the fire was the burning of incense to give "atmosphere" to a motion picture, flimsy stage draperies being ignited from the incense.

The coroner finds that violations of the law in the theater included the absence of the following safeguards: An asbestos curtain; an automatic sprinkler; hose connections, fire-proof scenery and woodwork.

The coroner says that had Building Inspector Austin done his duty in applying the building code the fire could not have occurred.

### FLOYD BOOTH, SON OF R. A. BOOTH COMMITTED SUICIDE CHRISTMAS

EUGENE, Dec. 27.—Floyd Booth, son of R. A. Booth, chairman of the Oregon state highway commission, committed suicide Christmas evening, shooting himself in the mouth with a revolver. The body was found about midnight in the basement of his home, Fifteenth and Mill streets, with the revolver in his hand.

Temporary derangement, due to illness and overwork is held responsible by his family. He had complained of distress during the day and had returned to his home alone after a Christmas dinner at the home of his parents. He is thought to have shot himself about 7 o'clock Sunday evening.

Booth had been ill for some time, according to his father, and, despite this, had been working day and night at the Oregon Drug company offices. He was financially interested in the company, a recently organized wholesale drug company of this city.

His wife, formerly Miss Edith Prescott, and three children, two boys and a girl, the eldest 19, survive. He was a graduate from the University of Oregon in 1919, and was a thirty-second degree Mason.

Mr. and Mrs. Booth had given a Christmas eve party in the basement of their home where he ended his life, that part of the house being fitted up with trees and greens to make it a typical forest.

"My son had no financial or other troubles," said R. A. Booth. "He had been in poor health for some time and had been working long hours, due to his interest in his new business."
