PROSPECTS BRIGHT FOR SUCCESS OF NEW GOLF CLUB

Prospects for the success of the Jackson County Golf club organization continue to improve. While the general canvass for members has not been started, almost one-third of the necessary membership has been signed up, a very encouraging feature being the fact that several residents of other towns in the county have written to the committee for application blanks, which have been signed and returned.

The committee feels so optimistic of success that it is anticipated there will be somewhat of a scramble for membership on the initial \$100 charter fee as the charter list approaches the limit set for membership at this low price. When the charter list is closed it is believed applicants on the waiting list will be admitted at a much larger fee, as is customary in all clubs of this kind.

It is hoped to start the general canvass in the very near future, but owing to the cold weather prevailing and the fact that the membership list continues to grow without solicitation the committee has been in no hurry to organize for the final drive.

The membership is open to the public of Jackson county and those interested can obtain all information from Ralph McCurdy or T. E. Daniels. Application blanks can be had at a number of prominent business houses as well as at the hotels.

SOUTHERN OREGON IS DECLARED RICH IN RARE PLANTS

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 20.—The Siskiyou mountain region in Southern Oregon is found to be of unusual interest from a botanical standpoint, since there are blended the plant types of the redwood age together with those of more modern origin, says John D. Guthrie of the United States forest service, who has received a report from Washington on a number of plant specimens sent to it for identification.

A total of 276 plant specimens, collected by Grating Examiner Ingram in the Siskiyou national forest, were sent to Washington for identification. From Washington comes the information that the specimens are rare finds, indeed, and requests are made for further samples and data as to where they are gathered.

Among the lot that was identified was the *cyperus vegetas* of the sedge family, which is related to the edible nut grass of the ancient Egyptians.

"This specimen is a botanical 'find,' since the plant is an old world species, and not listed in any manual of American plants," reads the report. "This is apparently the first record of its ever having been found in the United States."

Two grasses entirely new to the forest service were found, which were turned over to the United States national herbarium. A new lupine, which has never been named or described by anybody, was also mentioned in the assortment. One specimen could not be identified by anyone in the national museum, although botanists decided it was evidently related to the poppies. The Portland office was asked for more material.

The extremely rare Marshall gooseberry was one of the collection, and the likewise rare red dewberry, first discovered by Davis Douglas, the men for whom the Douglas fir was named.

An unusual species of juniper was another rare find, which the bureau of plant industry officials believed should have a specific rank and not be considered with common juniper, the common type.

Of Ingram's entire collection, 30 of the species were found to be entirely new to the forest service.
