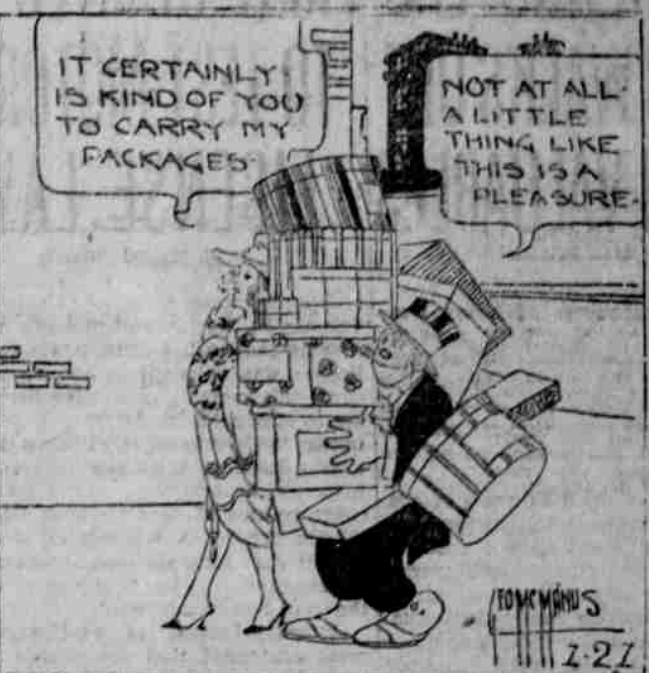

Gulf states extended its reaction by over seven points, making a total of more than 25 points from yesterday's high prices. Regional lost four points and declines of one to two and a half were sustained by Bethlehem, Crucible Great Northern Ore., Sioux Sheffield, Republic and Vanadium. Losses of 1 to 3 points were sustained by the principal oils, motors, equipments, chemicals, textiles and junior rails. Coppers, shippings and chain store issues strengthened. Closing prices were generally lower. Sales approximated 500,000 shares. Liberty bonds eased and other bonds were steady.
