LINCOLN ORATOR MAY BE NEXT MAYOR SEATTLE

Prof. Clark P. Bisset, of the University of Washington law school, of Seattle, who is to be the principal speaker at the Jackson County Lincoln banquet in the Medford hotel, Monday, Feb. 13, and who is recognized as one of the ablest orators on the coast and one of the greatest students of "the Great Emancipator," is a probable candidate for mayor of Seattle, says a Seattle dispatch to the Portland Oregonian.

The dispatch says in part: "Whether Professor Bisset can be brought into the contest for mayor is problematical. Throughout his connection with the university he has been devoted to his classes, sparing time only for patriotic and great work, of which he has done a public deal during the war.
