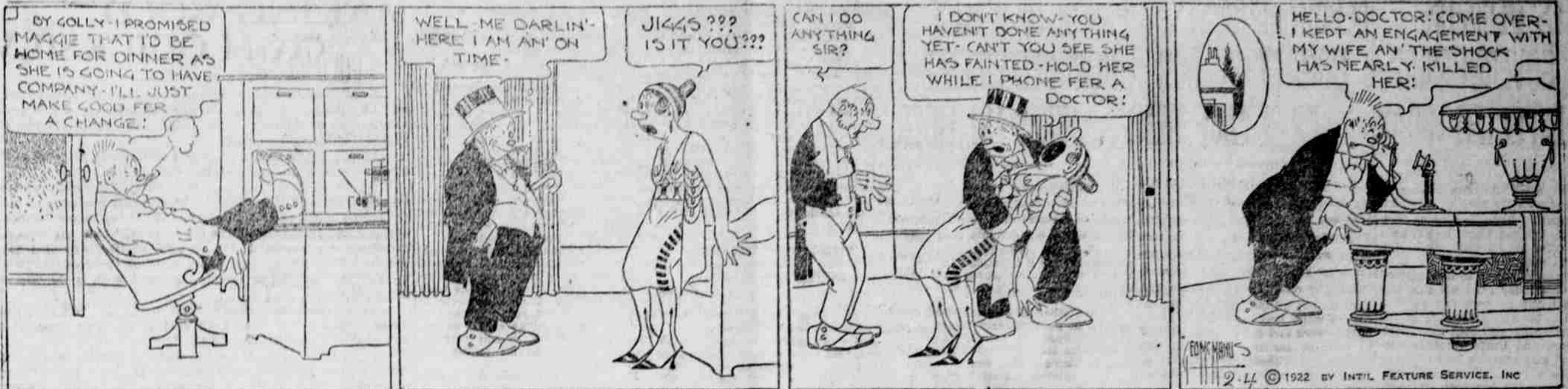


BRINGING UP FATHER

NEW YORK, Feb. 4.—The short interest in the stock market had another anxious time today the brief trading period being attended by further active buying of equipments, oils, motors and numerous specialties.

Baldwin, American and Lima Locomotives, Pullman, Westinghouse, Railway Steel Spring, Pressed Steel Car, Mexican Petroleum, Royal Dutch, Standard Oil of New Jersey, General Asphalt common and preferred, Studebaker, Chandler, Mercantile preferred, American Ice, American Tobacco and Famous Players common and preferred were prominent at the extreme gains of one to four points.

Bulls gave early promise of extending their recent advance, but interest in that quarter waned later. The closing was strong. Sales approximated 450,000 shares.

An easier tone was shown by Liberty issues, but other bonds were firm.
