ESPEE ORDERED TO ADOPT GRAIN RATE

SALEM, Ore., Feb. 16.—In a letter addressed to the Southern Pacific company today, Fred A. Williams, chairman of the public works service commission, calls upon that company to make good the grain rate reductions recently authorized by the interstate commerce commission. The controversy grew out of the refusal of the Southern Pacific to establish uniformly the ten per cent less differential on coarse grain than applying on wheat, in this respect differing from other trans-continental carriers, who have agreed to and published the greater reduction. COMPULSORY LABOR FOR BULGAR WOMEN

SOFIA, Feb. 16.—Compulsory work for women is to be imposed by the Bulgarian peasant government. The peasant women who do manual labor will take pleasure in seeing those ladies in silk stockings' rustle about a bit. Premier Stamboulsky, justifying the new law in a recent speech said: 'A peasant woman works in the country ploughing the ground, often doing more than her husband. She spins the wool and weaves the cloth for clothing. What does the town lady do? She walks and chats and does not give birth to children. We must at least compel her to labor for the state.' The law is to be applied first in the capital, Sofia.
