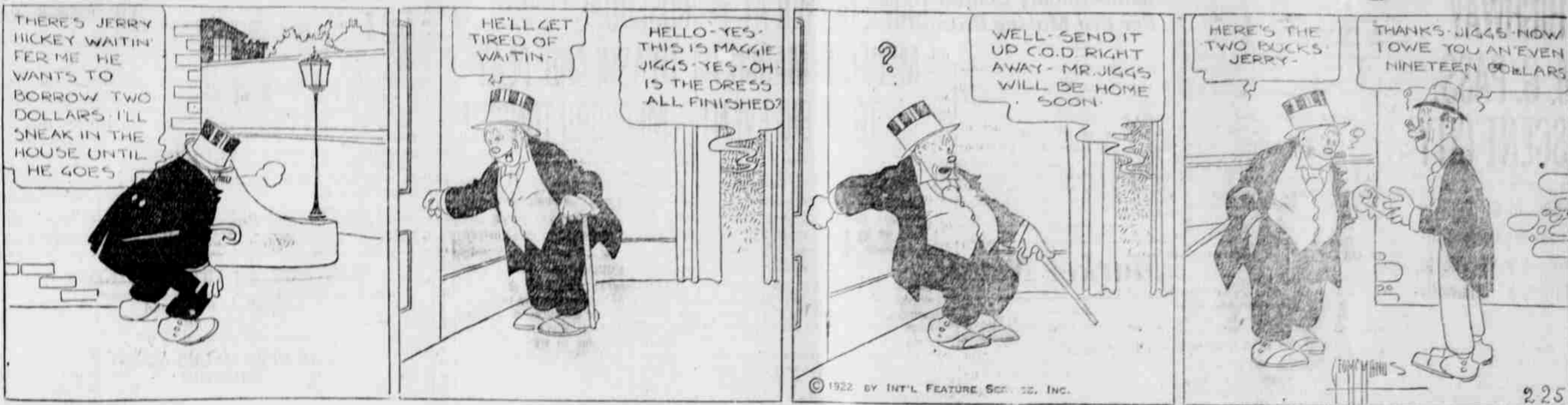


BRINGING UP FATHER



VISCOUNT HARCOURT IS DEAD, AGED 59

LONDON, Feb. 24.—(By the Associated Press)—Viscount Harcourt died here Thursday night, aged 59 years. Viscount Harcourt was born February 1, 1862, the son of Sir William George Granville Venables Vernon Harcourt, English statesman. He served at various times as privy councillor and was secretary of state for colonies in 1896. He was created Baron Northampton and Viscount Harcourt in 1917. His wife, who he married in 1899, was Mary Edith Burns, only daughter of the late Walter H. Burns of New York and North Hutton Park, Hatfield, England. From 1904 until he was raised to the peerage, he was a member of parliament and was known as a strong opponent of woman suffrage. He was offered the post of secretary of state for Ireland in July, 1916, but declined it. Besides Viscountess Harcourt he is survived by one son, Honorable William Edward Harcourt, Viscount Harcourt, a liberal in politics.
