Special Election Notice

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That a special election will be held on Saturday, the 25th day of March, 1922, at the hereinbefore specified polling place in the Talent Irrigation District, Jackson County, Oregon, to determine whether said district shall enter into an agreement with the State of Oregon, for the payment by the State of Oregon of interest to accrue in any or all of the first five years of any bonds which said district may have heretofore or may hereafter issue, and particularly referring to the two bond issues voted and authorized by the voters of the Talent Irrigation District, in the sum of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000.00) and of four hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000.00), respectively, under and pursuant to the provisions of Article XI-b of the Constitution of the State of Oregon.

The polls shall be opened at eight o'clock in the morning of the election, and kept open until five o'clock in the afternoon, when the same must be closed. At said election, the ballots shall contain the words: "AGREEMENT—YES," and "AGREEMENT—NO."

The Board of Directors have specified the following polling place in said district for said election:

In the Garage on the ranch owned by E. T. Nowby, and being situated about one-fourth mile west of the canyons at Talent, Oregon, and about one-fourth mile west of the northwest corner of the town of Talent, Jackson County, Oregon, and being the ranch formerly owned by the Talent Orchard Company; said polling place being within the boundaries of the Talent Irrigation District.

Said election must be held and the result thereof determined and declared in all respects in accordance with the method of election prescribed for general purpose of irrigation districts.
