RECOVERS \$100,000
ON HORSE DEAL

NEW YORK, Mar. 4.—Harry Sinclair, oil magnate and sportsman, was awarded \$100,000 by a jury in the Brooklyn superior court today in a suit against James S. Johnson to recover the purchase price of the race horse Playfellow, a brother of the noted thoroughbred Man o' War.

Sinclair brought suit to recover his money on the ground that Johnson had concealed from him the fact that Playfellow was a "cribber," and a "wind sucker."

Johnson denied that any warranty was given. This was the second trial.
