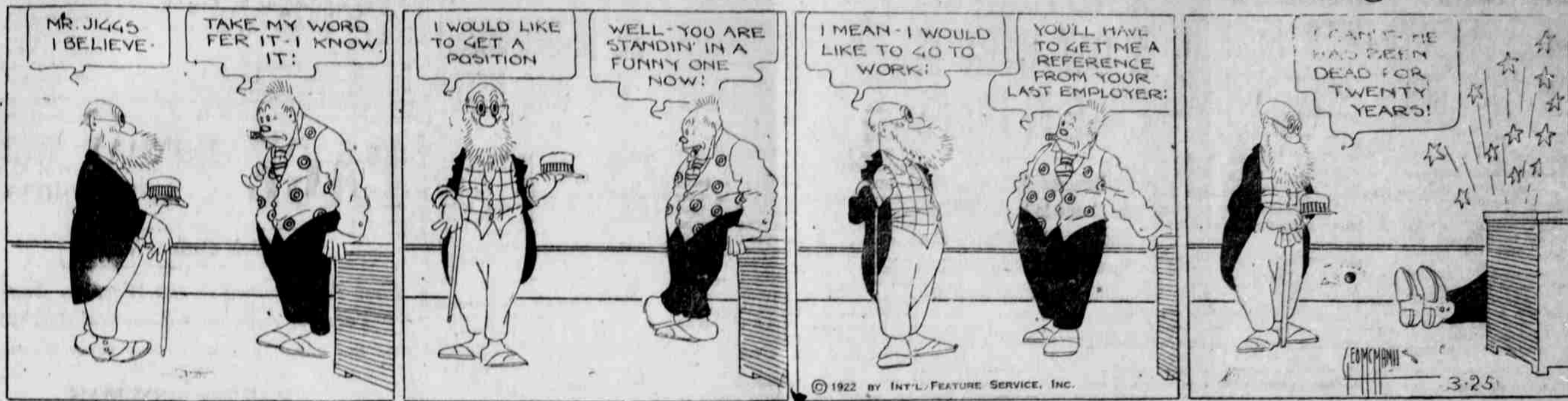

SWISS DECISION ON LATIN BOUNDARY IS COMPROMISE

The Swiss federal council, as arbitrator of the long-standing boundary dispute between Venezuela and Colombia has reached a decision, but the conclusions are being kept secret until the interested governments are officially informed. It is said, however, that a reconciliatory compromise has been proposed.
