NEW YORK, April 1.—Trading in stocks during today's two hours' session was governed by the usual week-end settlement of speculative issues. Prices reacted on selling of leaders, including Bethlehem Steel and Baldwin Locomotive, together with various specialties. The market rallied later on the demand for cheaper motors and rails, especially Pierce Arrow common and preferred. The latter included St. Paul preferred and Wabash preferred at gains of 1 and 1 1/2 points. The closing was strong. Sales approximated 400,000 shares.
