SAN FRANCISCO, April 25.—A contraband shipment of arms and ammunition, presumed to be for one of the revolutionary factions in China, was seized by customs officials today on the trans-Pacific liner Nanking of the China Mail Steamship company. The shipment was made up of 15,000 rounds of ammunition and a number of automatic pistols and rifles. It was concealed among the baggage of the steamer passengers. Last week contraband drugs estimated at more than \$40,000 was seized on the Nanking.
