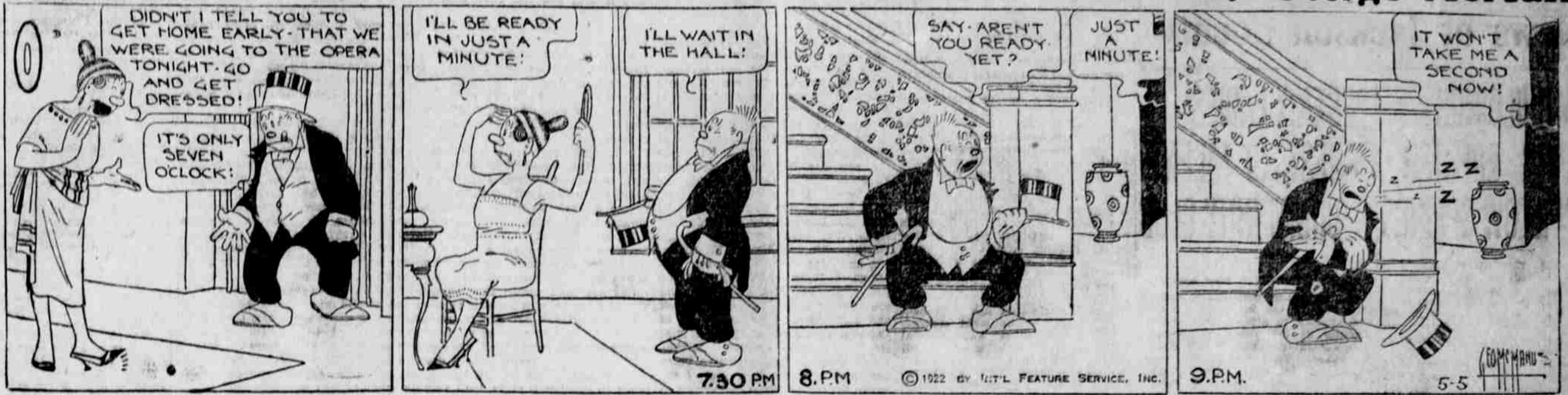


BRINGING UP FATHER

W. B. BIDDLE IS NAMED CHAIRMAN OREGON GROWERS

W. B. Biddle, Medford orchardist and former prominent railroad executive of the Santa Fe and Frisco lines, was named chairman of the Rogue river district of the Oregon Growers Packing Corporation, affiliated, at a meeting of the directors held last night. P. S. Woodin, Grants Pass businessman, was named secretary. Biddle succeeds Colonel Gordon Voorhies who declined to lead the local organization another year. The new head of the Growers is prominent in railroad circles in Chicago and St. Louis, where he formerly maintained his headquarters. Starting at the bottom of the ladder, Biddle worked his way near the top of the Santa Fe system, when he was named receiver for the Frisco system. Upon the completion of the refinancing of this system, the local man was named president, which position he held until he retired to his orchard, "Kenwood," north of Medford, a few years ago. The other members of the Southern Oregon district board are P. A. Scherer, C. C. Cate and A. H. Davenhill, the latter two being hold over members from last year's governing body. The board has named Col. Gordon Voorhies, Howard A. Hill, J. G. Love of Central Point, and Hamilton Patton, Medford businessmen, members of the advisory committee.
