EL PASO, Texas, May 16.—An infuriated mob of 400 peracos in a Durango, Mexico, village, who drove Miss Elizabeth Streever over the town during the night of May 4, confiscated Bibles from Miss Streever's party and used them for fuel for bonfires, according to Rev. Emigdio G. Santos, one of the mob's victims. The latter made a sworn statement, an English translation of which was received today by Mrs. J. B. Lancaster of El Paso, wife of the Methodist presiding elder of the Terroton district.
