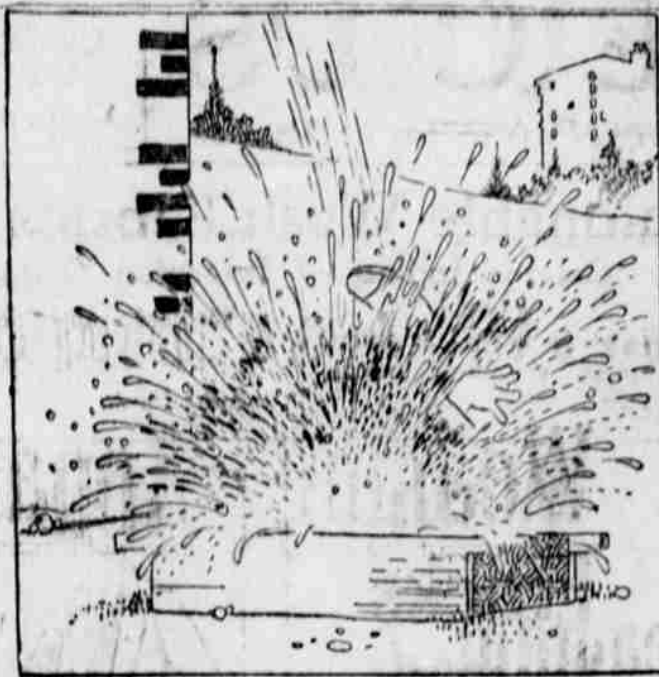


BRINGING UP FATHER



LEONARD WOOD SAFE ON LAND

MANILA, P. I., May 24.—Leonard Wood, governor general of the Philippines, is safe after being missed 36 hours in the yacht Apo, following a typhoon, today. The yacht was reported to have taken refuge at an island near Mindanao where the governor accompanied by his wife and daughter had gone Saturday on an inspection trip.

Since the typhoon, keen anxiety had been felt for the safety of General Wood and his family. The Apo is a small yacht and vessels generally in the vicinity of the island of Mindanao were driven helplessly before the storm. For two days efforts to reach the Apo were unavailing.
