NEW YORK, May 27.—Recent favorites of the oil, motor, steel and tobacco groups led today's active stock market to higher grounds. Studebaker, Mexican Petroleum, Republic Iron, Tobacco Products common and preferred and Sumatra Tobacco scored extreme gains of 1 1/2 to 4 points. Shipping, chemicals and specialties, notably American International, Industrial Alcohol, Famous Players and Coca Cola were one to two points higher. Aside from Lake Erie and Western common and preferred and Reading, second preferred, the demands for rails were light. The closing was strong. Sales approximated 750,000 shares.
