

HOPES TO ESCAPE ELECTRIC CHAIR ON RUBBER BOOTS

HERKIMER, N. Y., May 31.

Upon a pair of rubber boots, Rutger Warder, awaiting execution at Sing Sing prison for the murder of Henry Werner here in February, 1921, bases his hope of escaping the electric chair. Attorneys for the condemned man here announced that they will appeal for another trial on the ground of newly discovered evidence in the form of rubber boots.

After the discovery of Werner's body in a ravine suspicion was directed to Warder and the dead man's widow. Under pressure of questioning Warder declared that he was in love with Mrs. Werner and that as she would not leave her husband, he shot Werner while on a rabbit hunting trip. After Warder's conviction, Mrs. Werner was placed on trial and Warder, a witness at the trial, changed his story, saying that Mrs. Werner killed her husband with an axe and that he helped her carry the body to the place where it was later found. In order to hide the axe wound, he said, he fired his gun at Werner's head. Warder also testified that when they took away Werner's body, Mrs. Werner put on a pair of rubber boots over her shoes.

According to Warder's lawyer the rubber boots that have recently been found show on the inside the impression of the heel of a woman's shoe.

A few weeks ago, Warder was removed from the death house at Sing Sing to the prison hospital where an operation for appendicitis was performed upon him.
