YAKIMA, Wash., June 19.—Rev. L. F. Sawyer of the Baptist church, who some time ago called a congregational meeting to consider re-enactment of an ordinance of 1893, which banned theatre going, card playing and dancing, on Sunday submitted his resignation to the congregation, which accepted it. The congregation did not re-enact the ordinance. Rev. Mr. Sawyer left a sealed envelope with his board of deacons when he recently left for the east, and wired instructions that it be opened Sunday. It contained his resignation.

Automatic Lighthouse
Latest Marine Device

LONDON.—A self acting lighthouse is the latest device to be erected by the Board of Trade to warn navigators of the proximity of danger. One has been installed at Barry Holmes, Gower, on the Swansea coast and has given entire satisfaction. It lights itself when it gets dark, and extinguishes itself when daylight returns. It requires no attention from keepers. So completely automatic is its action that it needs no care except from time to time to feed it with chemicals, and each of its gas tanks hold supplies sufficient for two years. Its lamp is comparatively small but emits a very powerful and far-penetrating light.
