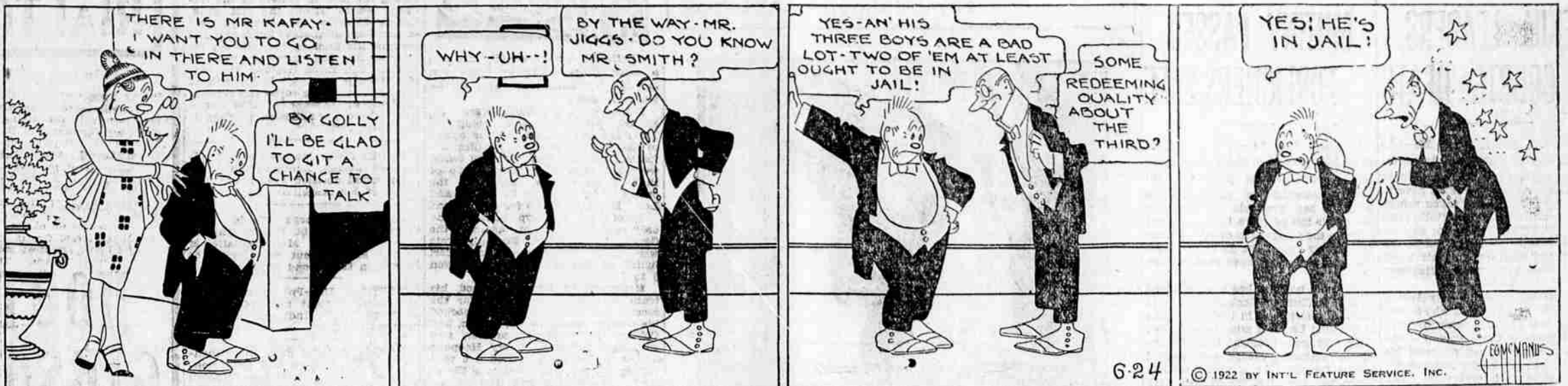


BRINGING UP FATHER

SPECIAL FRUIT TRAIN
YAKIMA TO ST. PAUL

SPOKANE, Wash., June 24.—Installation of a special fruit train of refrigerator express cars from Yakima direct to St. Paul, Minn., was announced here today by officials of the Northern Pacific railroad. One train, it was stated, will be made up at Yakima at 3 p. m., and will stop at Pasco to pick up the Milton and Freewater, Oregon crops. The schedule for another train, to leave in the morning, has not been completed.

NEW YORK, June 24.—Oils and rails were the features of speculative interest during today's brief and comparatively dull stock market. Mexican Petroleum rebounded 6 1/2 points on the statement of the company's financial position and prospective earnings. Pan American petroleum added to yesterday's gains, and Producers and Refiners, California Petroleum and General Asphalt were substantially better. New York Central featured the rails, rising over 2 points. Leading transcontinentals, grangers and coalers were again purchased by commission houses. Several of the motor, rubber and tobacco specialties made moderate gains. The closing was firm. Sales approximated 400,000 shares.
