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WHEAT SHIPPED TO EUROPE MARKS IN PRICE DECLINE

CHICAGO, July 18.—Absence of any definite indication of progress towards settlement of the rail strike led to untimely in wheat prices today during the early transactions. Bulls put stress too on estimates that 700,000 to 1,000,000 bushels had been taken for Europe on yesterday's decline in the market. On the other hand weather conditions today remained adverse to development of black rust. Opening prices which were unchanged to 1/2 higher, with September \$1.12 1/2 to \$1.12 3/4 and December \$1.14 1/2 to \$1.14 3/4, were followed by a slight sag, then by fresh general gains.

Corn and oats were firmer with wheat. After opening unchanged to 1/2 higher, September 64 to 64 1/2, the corn market scored a slight general advance.

Oats started 1/4 @ 1/2 off to 3/4 higher, September 36 to 36 1/2 and later hardened a little all around.

Higher quotation on hogs strengthened the provision market.

NEW YORK, July 18.—Steels, equipments and a wide assortment of other industrials and kindred issues registered extreme gains of two to almost seven points in today's stock market, rails alone showing little improvement. Sales approximated 650,000 shares.

All classes under strike conditions best explained by Chairman Ben W. Hooper of the United States Railroad Labor Board in his statement of July 1st, reading as follows:

"In this case the conflict is not between the employer and the oppressed employee. The people of the country, through an act of Congress, signed by President Wilson, established a tribunal to decide such disputes over wages and working conditions which are submitted to it in a proper manner. It is the decision of this tribunal against which the shop crafts are striking. Regardless of any question of the right of the men to strike the men who take the strikers' places are merely accepting the wages and working conditions prescribed by a government tribunal and are performing a public service. They are not accepting the wages and working conditions which an employer is trying to impose. For this reason, public sentiment and full government power will protect the men who remain in their positions and new men who may come in."

Adequate provisions have been made for the full protection of all new employees, the same as old employees who have remained loyally at work.
