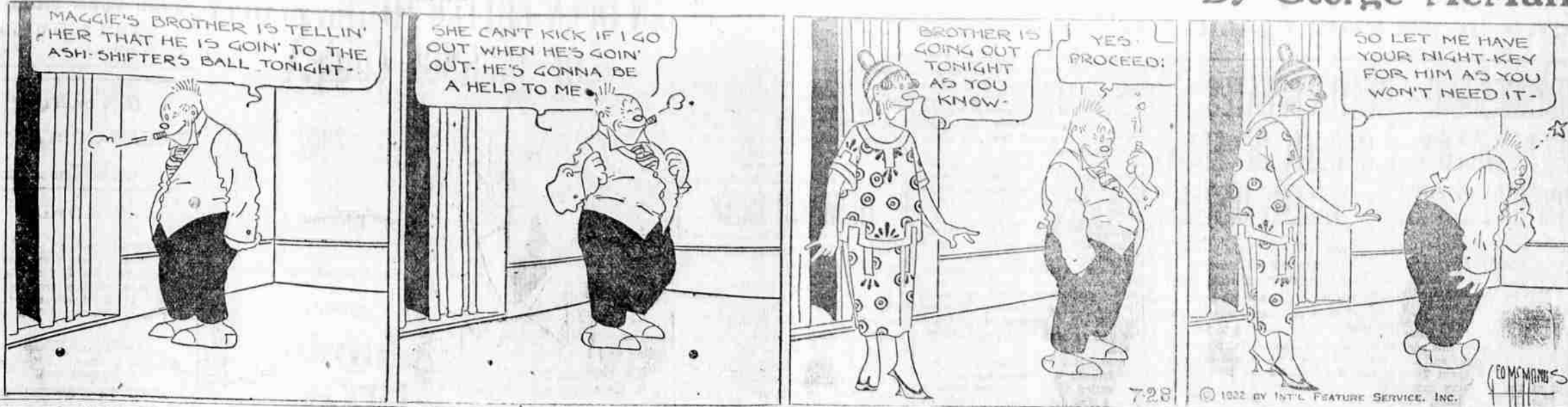

Three Hanged for Murder

ESTANCIA, N. M., July 28.—Three men were hanged here at 7 o'clock this morning for the murder of Anton Cury, a merchant of Duran, N. M., last September. A fourth man who was convicted was granted a reprieve at the last minute pending an appeal of his case to the supreme court.

Mrs. Cury, widow of the slain merchant, was a silent watcher at the hangings. The three, Carlos Renteria, Ysidro Miranda and Luis Medrano, were put on scaffolds and the three traps were sprung simultaneously.
