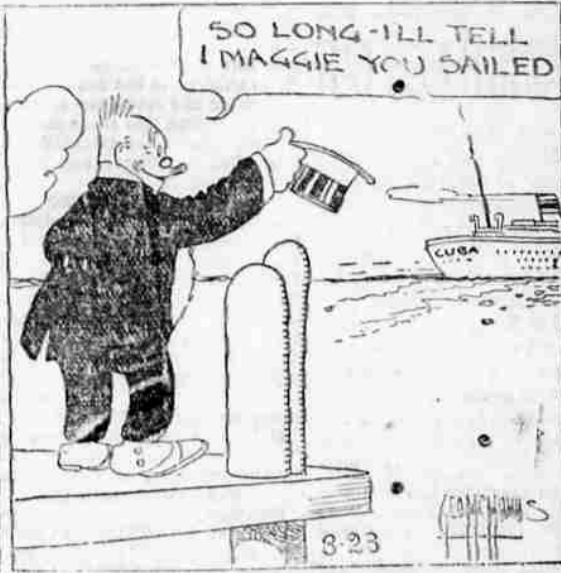
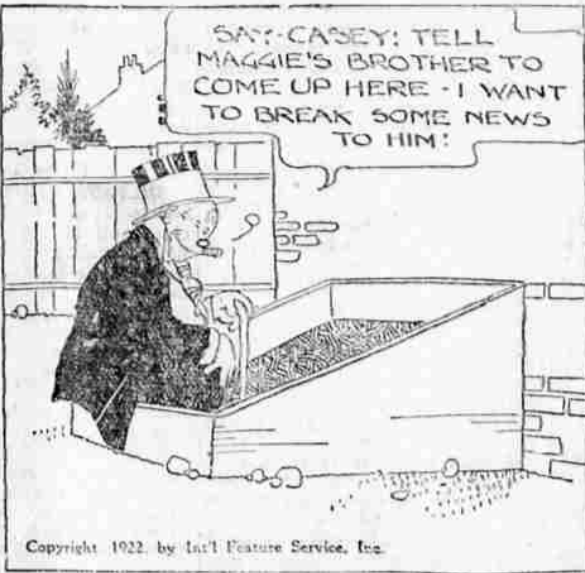

PRESIDENT HUNG IS READY TO RESIGN FAVOR OF SUN YAT

SHANGHAI, Aug. 5.—(By the Associated Press)—Sun Yat Sen, leader of the south China faction, announced today that peace reigns again between the north and the south and that "the war is ended." PEKING, Aug. 23.—(By Associated Press). The republican cabinet announced today that President Li Yuan Hung is willing to resign in favor of Sun Yat Sen, deposed head of the south China government, provided parliament approves such action. It has been learned in official circles here that President Li is disposed to be friendly toward Sun, who is still in conference at Shanghai with representatives of the opposing factions whose differences have seriously interfered with the plans of the Peking administration to re-unite China under one government. Envoys of the republic, sent to Shanghai to invite Sun to meet representatives of the republic in Peking are still urging Sun to come to the capital, but he refuses to come until he has been assured the various military factions have settled their differences. Consequently Chang Tho-Lin, governor of Manchuria, and Wu Pei Fu, military leader of north China have entered into negotiations looking to an agreement on the issues on which they have been at odds. Cabinet members told the Associated Press today that these negotiations between China's two leading military rivals were progressing. It was decided if Chang and Wu agreed to harmonize Sun would be disposed to proceed to Peking.
