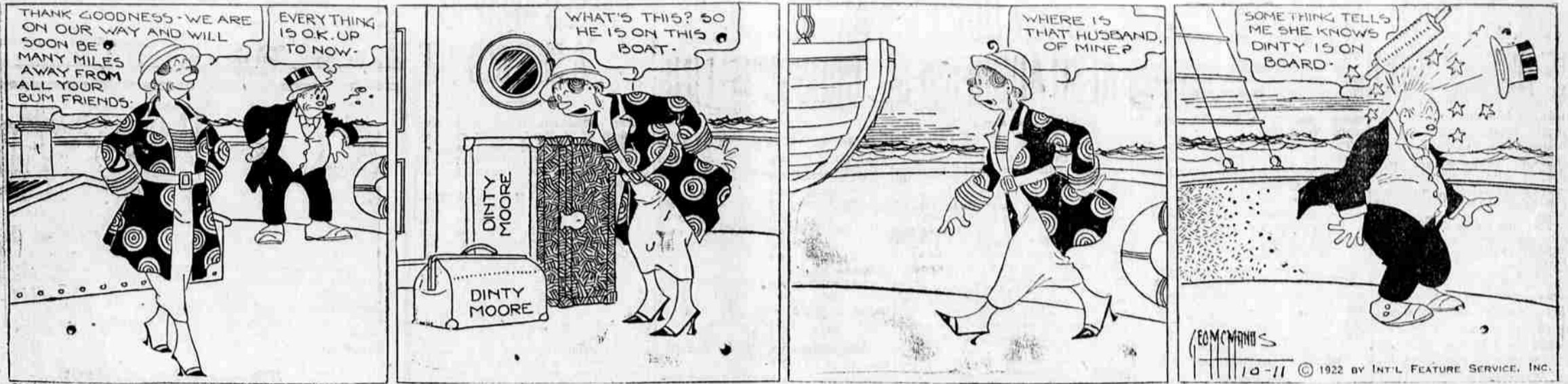

# FORD HAS ONLY STARTED FIGHT MUSCLE SHOALS

DETROIT, Mich., Oct. 12.—(By Associated Press.) Renewal of the lease under which the Alabama Power company operates the government's electrical generating steam plant at Muscle Shoals has no bearing whatever on the offer of Henry Ford to take over and operate the Muscle Shoals property, nor has it any bearing on the status of that offer, officials of the Ford Motor company said today.

Representatives of Mr. Ford reiterated today previous statements credited to the manufacturer that he had only begun his fight to obtain control of Muscle Shoals.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 12.—Renewal for another year of the lease under which the Alabama Power company operates the government electrical generating steam plant at Muscle Shoals was announced today by Secretary Weeks.

The contract was renewed on the same terms as originally negotiated, a step which Secretary Weeks said was necessary to "enable a number of cotton mills and other industries in states including North and South Carolina to continue operations which otherwise would be compelled to close down or materially curtail production because of disturbed conditions in coal and transportation industries and lack of developed hydro-electric power."
