SIKI SAYS HIS BOUT WITH CARPENTIER FAKE

PARIS, Dec. 4.—(By the Associated Press)—Batting Siki, the Senegalese conqueror of Georges Carpentier, declared today in the presence of Deputy Diagne and two witnesses that his fight with Carpentier for the light-heavyweight world's championship had been "faked," but that during the fight he had determined to be the winner. Siki said that once he was in the ring with a crowd of 50,000 people acclaiming him and conscious of his own strength he had a revulsion of feeling, despite the reminders from his corner, during his minute's rest after the third round, and had decided to go in and win.
