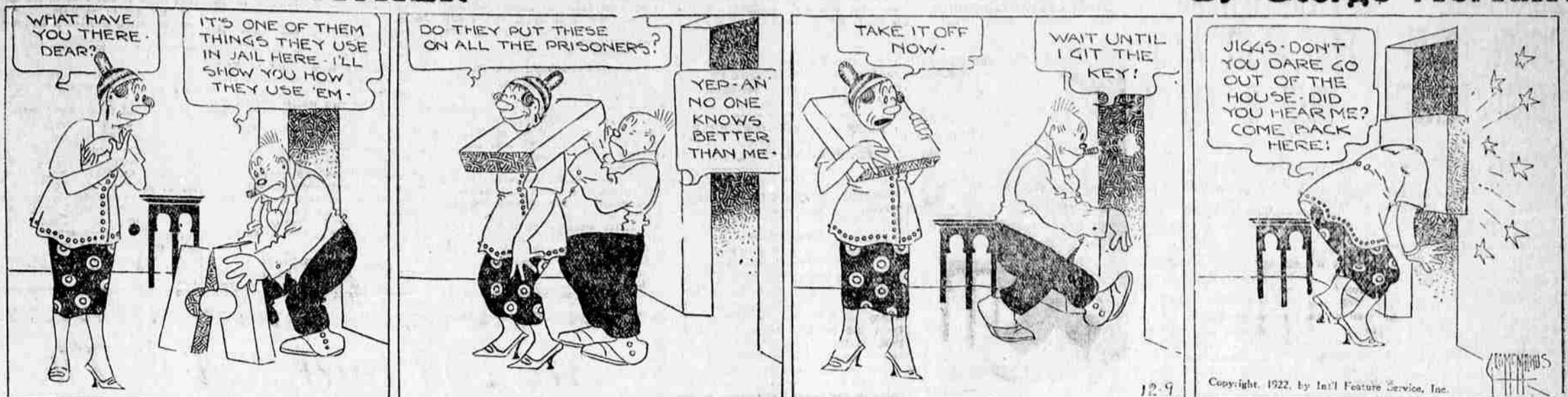


BRINGING UP FATHER



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BANDITS THREATEN TO KIDNAP AMERICANS

TSING TAO, Dec. 8.—(By the Associated Press)—Bandits still were moving about the city openly today, and it was reported that they were threatening to kidnap the British and American consuls and to hold them as hostages.

Fresh apprehension was caused by trouble with the Japanese railway, water works and electrical workers who threatened to strike. Japanese employees on the wharves stopped work today.

Every outgoing train was overcrowded with persons fleeing from the zone of danger. Japanese sentries were guarding the British consulate.
