Seaplane Wrecked On Florida Coast, Four Are Drowned

KEY WEST, Fla., Jan. 15.—Efforts were renewed today following fruitless attempts yesterday by water and air to recover the bodies of E. F. Atkins, Jr., his two children, Edwin, III, and David Atkins of New York, and Miss Grace McDonald, who perished when the seaplane Columbus was wrecked and sunk in the ocean 21 miles north of Havana Saturday. The five survivors who were rescued by the ferryboat Henry M. Flager are reported today beyond all danger with the exception of Mrs. E. F. Atkins, Jr., who is suffering from exposure.
