Atkins, Jr., his two children, Edwin, III, and David Atkins of New York, and Miss Grace McDonald, who perished when the seaplane Columbus was wrecked and sunk in the ocean 21 miles north of Havana Saturday. five survivors who were rescued by the férryboat Henry M. Flager are re ported today beyond all danger with the exception of Mrs. E. F. Atkins, Jr. who is suffering from exposure.
