OFFERS DEMPSEY A COOL MILLION FOR H. WILLS GO

NEW YORK, Jan. 25.—The value of a knockout blow to Jack Dempsey, world's champion pugilist, is going up. He awoke today to see in the papers that Tom O'Rourke, matchmaker of the Polo Grounds was prepared to guarantee him \$1,000,000 to fight Harry Wills, his negro challenger, and any two of the other applicants who now are crowding for the lightweight title.

The champion's manager, who arrived yesterday, declared that a Dempsey-Wills bout would be held this year if he (Kearns) must stage it. Before meeting Wills, Kearns proposed that Dempsey have a return match with Jess Willard, former champion, and one other selection. Two bouts are necessary to prepare Dempsey for the negro, Kearns said.

NEW YORK, Jan. 25.—"Babe" Ruth, home run artist of the New York Yankees, was back in New York today for further treatment of the finger on his left hand that was operated on last week for an infection. He said he would remain here at least until Saturday or longer.

Since retiring to his farm at Sudbury, Mass., the Bambino has disposed of twenty pounds and will be back in the best condition in which he ever has reported for a season's work when he joins the Yankees' pitchers in the hot baths at Hot Springs next month, he said.

Thye won a fall after an hour and ten minutes of wrestling with a wrist lock. The match was supposed to be for two hours but Sauer was unable to continue as a result of being hurled to the mat with such force that he was rendered groggy. His head struck on the boards at the edge of the mat.

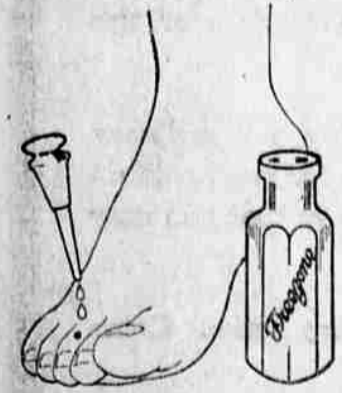
