IRISH FREE STATERS TO GRAB D'VALERA

LONDON, Feb. 20.—(By the Associated Press)—A dispatch to the Evening News of Belfast today says the freedom Emomn DeValera has enjoyed so far has given a great impetus to the republican movement, the irregulars getting the impression that the free staters are afraid to arrest him, as De Valera is living in and about Dublin and may be interviewed daily without difficulty. "Such a paradoxical state of affairs will soon be ended," says the correspondent, "for the free state leaders have determined to give him the same share as the dupes he directs." The correspondent adds that there is little doubt but that the revolt would collapse if he chiefs were in custody. The rebels in the Arigna mountains region, whom the free state forces have been campaigning against, are reported to have been broken up.
