JOIE RAY GETS REVENGE, BEATS RITOLA IN N. YORK

NEW YORK, Mar. 8.—Joie Ray of Chicago has evened up matters with his rival on the track, Willie Ritola of New York. Ray set a new world's record of 14.54 for the 5000 meter run in defeating Ritola here last night. Last week Ritola beat Ray in a three mile run.

CALGARY, Alta., Mar. 8.—Jack Taylor, Canadian heavyweight wrestling champion, made good here last night in an undertaking to throw Harry Mammas, Boston, Grecian, twice in an hour. Both falls were by hammerlocks, the first in one and a half and the second in two minutes.

WASHINGTON, Mar. 8.—Albert Hansen of Rosebud, Mont., is the new .22 caliber slow fire gallery pistol champion and T. K. Lee of Birmingham, Ala., rapid fire pistol champion of the United States according to results announced today by the National Rifle association under whose auspices the events were conducted. Hansen's score was 580 out of a possible 600 in the slow fire contest and Lee, runner up in this event, scored 571 while W. W. John of Cristobal, Canal Zone, was third with 561. Lee won the rapid fire pistol championship with an aggregate score of 538 out of a possible 600, John being runner up with 490 and J. V. Carriffe, also of Cristobal, third with 489.

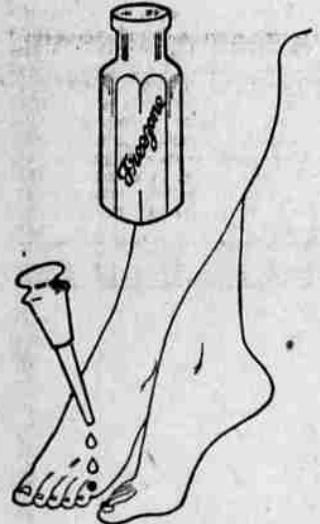
KANSAS CITY—Authorities prevented a boxing exhibition between Jess Willard, former heavyweight champion and his sparring partner.

GOOD YEAR

GREAT BRITAIN NOT FEARFUL OF NEAR EAST WAR

LONDON, March 8.—(By the Associated Press)—The announcement that the Turkish grand national assembly at Angora had instructed the government to undertake fresh peace negotiations with the allies for the purpose of having the Lausanne treaty conform with the Turkish national pact, has struck a note of discouragement among the British diplomatists in London who fear that negotiations based upon what they term the inordinate demands of the national pact would prove futile. These officials now anticipate further tedious conferences.

While Great Britain is taking every measure of prudence toward military and naval defense in the zone of the straits in the event of failure to reach a final agreement it is thought that military coercion will not be necessary. Officials here consider that the Angora government's rejection of the treaty is intended more than anything as a gesture of Turkey's government for home consumption.

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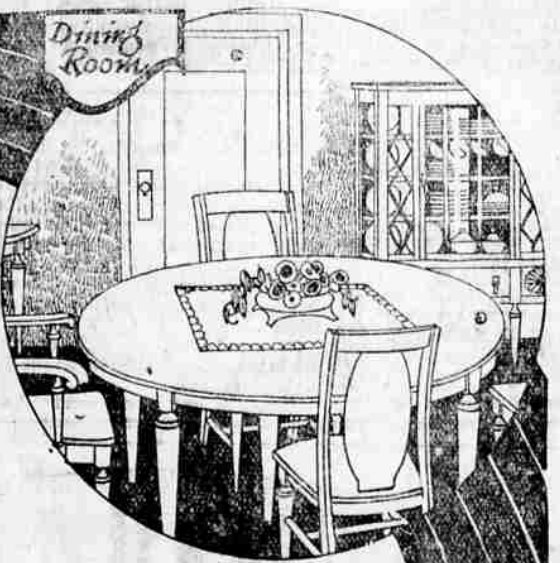
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
