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CONVICT FLOGGER
ACCUSED MURDER

MADISON, Fla., April 12.—At liberty here today on bail of \$10,000, Walter Higginbotham, convict camp "whipping boss," is awaiting trial for first degree murder in connection with the death of Martin Tabert of North Dakota, who witnesses said, was beaten to death by Higginbotham.

Late yesterday the Madison county grand jury in session here for investigation of Tabert's death, indicted Higginbotham on three counts charging murder.
