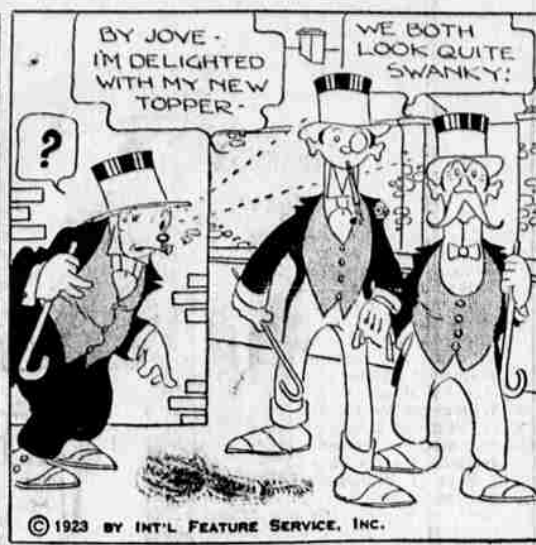

STEEPLEJACK FALLS FOR SEVENTH TIME, NOT HURT AS USUAL

LOS ANGELES, April 25.—Elmer Goss, 19 year old steeplejack, has had another fall. And, as usual, he escaped injury, also as usual, his fellow workman was badly injured.

This fall was fifty feet. Goss landed on his feet and remarked, "this is getting to be an old story." James Smeder, his companion, was hurried to the receiving hospital where it was said he had suffered many cuts and bruises and the fracture of several bones.

Goss has been in six former falls, in four of which his companions were killed while in the fifth, his fellow workman suffered a fractured skull. "It's just luck," said Goss. "Oh, I suppose I'll be killed some day, but I hate to give up the work as long as I make \$50 a day."

HOOVER TO PROBE LABOR EFFICIENCY

WASHINGTON, April 25.—In an endeavor to establish the economic facts involved in immigration restriction, Secretary Hoover has instituted a commerce department inquiry into the efficiency of labor.

Mr. Hoover said today that since 1914 when immigration practically ceased, individual productivity of workers in the United States has markedly increased.

"Social considerations involved in the immigration problem far outweigh any economic conditions or arguments that might be made for allowing unchecked immigration," Secretary Hoover said. "About 99 per cent of the people in the United States for sound and sufficient social reasons, favor immigration restrictions, but its effect on industrial operations ought to be determined, and this is what has been aimed at."
