DRY DECISION IN EFFECT JUNE 10TH

WASHINGTON, May 3.—Definite decision has been reached by administration officials charged with prohibition enforcement to put the ship liquor ban into effect on June 10, and Secretary Hughes has been requested to notify maritime nations that foreign ships entering American territorial waters on and after that date will be held to strict compliance with the law as interpreted by the supreme court.

At a meeting of the Helena Clearing House association last evening a committee was named to examine and analyze the assets of the institution. This was in proceeding. Inability of the Joint Stock Land bank, owned by the Banking Corporation, to meet land bank coupons maturing in New York is said to be the chief cause of the present difficulty.

CAPITAL OF CHINESE PROVINCE CAPTURED

AMOI, China, May 3.—(By the Associated Press)—Letters received here say that troops from Foochow, capital of this province, (Fukien) captured Hankiang, about fifty miles south of Foochow, on April 23, after two hours of fighting in which the southern army retreated to Hang-hwa. Casual combats are reported to have continued in the vicinity for several days, with a big battle expected between Hang-hwa and Chian-chowfu.
