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PANAMA AFRAID OF U. S. ABSORPTION

PANAMA, May 11.—(By Associated Press). In a memorandum submitted to Secretary of War Weeks, the government of Panama asserts the United States should definitely declare that it now holds all land necessary for the protection of the waterway, thereby affording a safeguard against expropriation which might eventually result in the absorption of the entire republic.

The memorandum sets forth Panama's position with regard to several points in her relations with the United States. It is necessary, the communication says, that Panama should have means of crossing the canal without hindrance. Inasmuch as certain Panama railroads may be used by the American government for strategic purposes the note says the bridges on such highways should be of heavy construction and suggests that the United States pay for such improvements.

MINISTER'S BODY IS FOUND IN SOUND

SEATTLE, May 11.—The body of the Rev. Galen Wood, 71, retired minister of the Christian (disciples of Christ) church, was found floating in Elliott Bay here today by a harbor tugboat. Mr. Wood, who was acting as a night watchman, is believed to have been stricken suddenly while standing on a pier of the Washington Tag and Barge company.

Mr. Wood for many years was a missionary in Montana, Alaska and Washington and was widely known in church circles of the Pacific northwest up to the time of his retirement several years ago.

Record Animal Catch In Washington State

OLYMPIA, Wash., May 11.—A record April catch was made by state, federal and co-operative hunters last month, according to Predatory Animal Inspector Bach. There were 268 animals captured, an average of 14 per man. They included eight bob cats, one stock-killing bear, 110 adult coyotes, 146 coyote pups, one fox and two badgers. In addition 56 unborn coyotes and four unborn bob cats were destroyed.

POSTMASTER PLEADS FOR G. O. P. SOLIDARITY

MANSFIELD, Ohio, May 11.—(By the Associated Press).—Admitting a division in the ranks of the republican party but at the same time declaring "the state of our democratic adversaries is no better," Postmaster General Harry S. New, in an address here last night, asserted that both parties are suffering from "lack of cohesion."

The postmaster general pleaded with his auditors for party solidarity against "blobs, individuals with pet theories and fragmentary factions." He was the principal speaker at the centennial celebration of the birth of John Sherman, Mansfield's most famous citizen.
