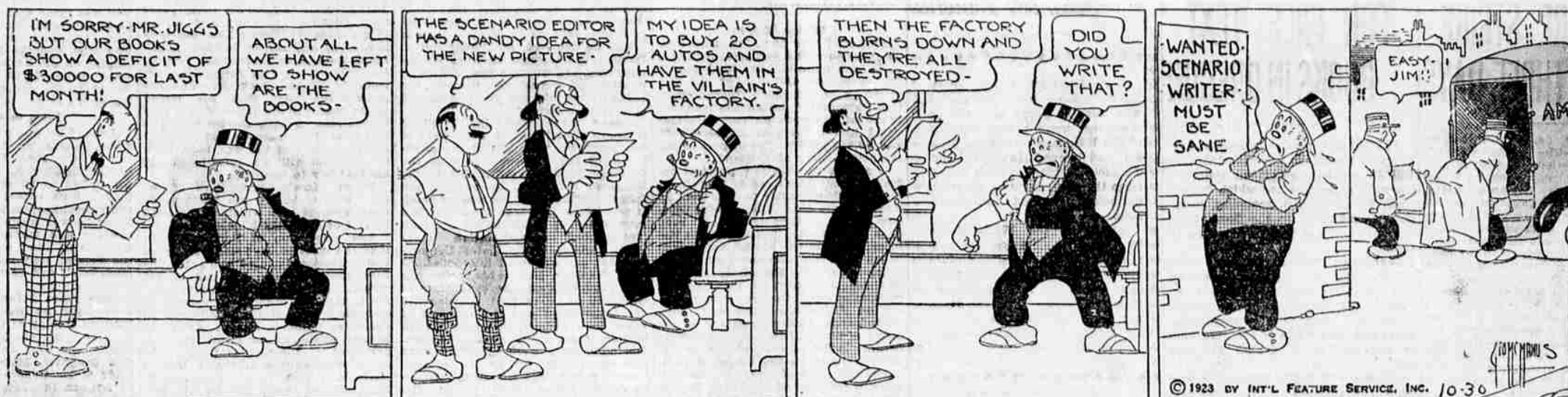

Houses should be set at a uniform distance from the street and face the street. Fast growing shade trees should be set out all along the street.
