CANADIAN FLOUR IS LEADING IN BERLIN

WASHINGTON, Oct. 31.—American flour is meeting sharp competition Canadian flour in German markets, according to a report to the department of agriculture from its commissioner in Berlin. This was ascribed partly to the quality of the Canadian flour, but also to the fact that Canadian mills are satisfied to accept payment in cash documents at Hamburg, whereas American mills will only sell against sight draft on New York.
