

SPECULATION RIFE ON SUCCESSOR TO PROS. ATTY. MOORE

The announcement by Rawles Moore yesterday afternoon that he had resigned his position as district attorney of Jackson county to become effective practically at once, and with it an explanation to the public of his reasons for resigning, created much surprise throughout the city and county.

His successor, to serve out his unexpired term of over a year, will be named by Governor Walter N. Pierce, and hence in this city and elsewhere today speculation was rife as to who would receive the appointment.

Mr. Moore had nothing further to say about his resignation except that he hoped to be clear of the office as soon as possible and that when released from its duties he would devote his entire time to private law practice, and would retain his present offices in the Medford Center building.

General opinion here today held to the belief that Governor Pierce would appoint O. C. Boggs of Medford to the office, inasmuch as, some time ago he appointed Mr. Boggs as special prosecutor to prosecute liquor law violation cases in this county. District Attorney Moore objected to this appointment, held that it was unjust and illegal, and had begun proceedings in the supreme court to question the legal right of such an appointment, which he was compelled to forego because of the train holdup and murders taking all his time.

It became known today that Don Newbury, republican, well known young Medford attorney and American Legion veteran, was a candidate for the appointment. Speculation also had it that Attorney William Briggs of Ashland might obtain the appointment, as it has been known for some time past he would be a candidate on the republican ticket for the office when Rawles Moore's four year term expired.
