WALTON PLEADS NOT GUILTY TO KLAN CHARGES

LAWTON, Okla., Nov. 7.—(By Associated Press.) United States District Judge John H. Cotterall late today denied an application of Governor J. C. Walton for a writ of subpoena and a restraining order which would have prevented his impeachment trial before the state senate.

Judge Cotterall held that the federal court did not have jurisdiction in the case.

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla., Nov. 7.—(By Associated Press.) The state senate court of impeachment recessed late today until ten a. m. tomorrow after Governor Walton had entered a plea of not guilty to each of the 22 charges contained in the impeachment bill against him and had made a detailed answer to five of the charges.

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla., Nov. 7.—(By Associated Press.) Governor J. C. Walton pleaded not guilty today to each of the 22 impeachment charges filed against him.

The executive's counsel, in filing answers to the charges, submitted explanations of their stand on each article, in a lengthy document of approximately 30,000 words. The senate clerk began reading the answer.
