

REPORT CANADAY DENIED JOB BY DEPT. OF INTERIOR

Jackson county politics play a role in the opening guns of the U. S. senatorial campaign in the latest announcement of C. N. (Pat) McArthur, who has announced his candidacy, in reply to the statement of U. S. Sena-

tor Charles L. McNary, issued Tuesday. The portion of McArthur's statement having to do with this section reads as follows:

"Senator McNary says he is unalterably opposed to the injection of racial and religious issues into politics. This sounds good, but it does not square with Senator McNary's actions in recommending members of the Ku Klux Klan for appointment to important federal offices. In addition to his recommendation of Dr. Earl C. McFarland for collector of customs for the port of Portland, Senator McNary has recommended H. A. Canaday, a reputed klanman at Medford, for receiver of the United States

land office at Roseburg. He made this recommendation some weeks ago and has since been advised by the department of the interior that his nominee will not be appointed."

It was known locally that Captain Canaday was a seeker for the place held by former Mayor W. H. Canon, also that agents of the department of the interior spent some time in this city on the matter, but it was not known that the Washington government had declined confirmation.

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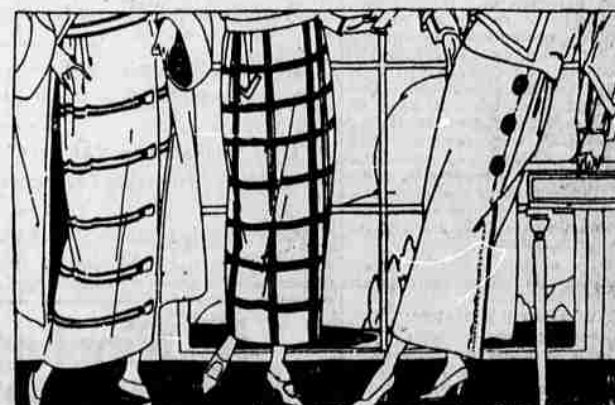
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
