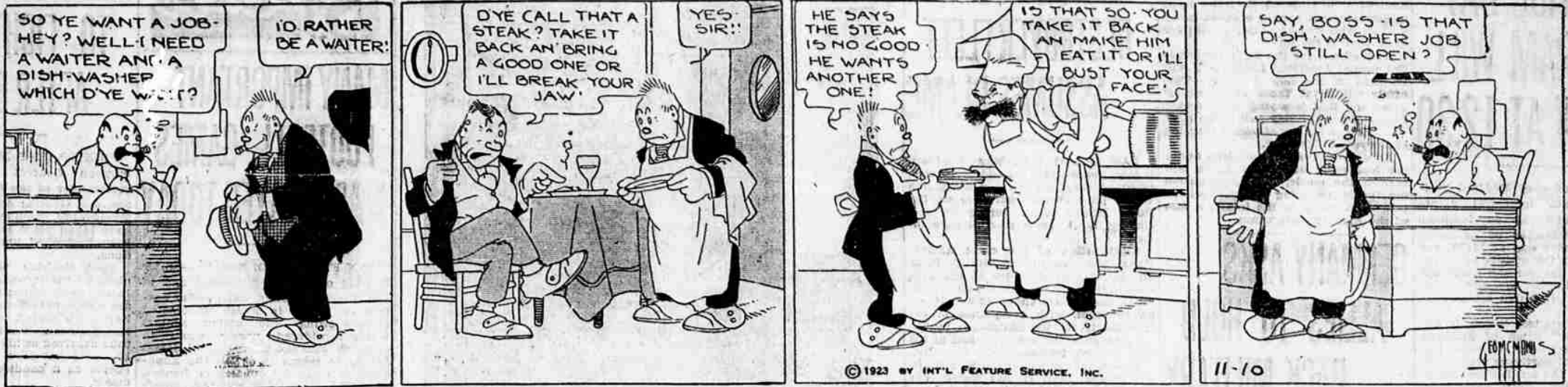


BRINGING UP FATHER

UNVEIL MONUMENT TO LATE LEGION LEADER
