GRAND JURY WILL VIEW MAIL CAR

A vivid reminder of the hold up of Southern Pacific train 13 at the Siskiyou tunnel some time ago, during which four of the trainmen were murdered by the bandits, is the mail car, which was partially blown up and burned, and which is now standing on a side track near the Medford depot. In this car Mail Clerk Dougherty met tragic death.

The car, which was brought here from Ashland early this afternoon, attracted considerable attention and was viewed closely by hundreds of citizens, will be inspected by the grand jury next week, probably Monday, incidental to the investigation by that body into the tragic affair in an effort to return indictments against the suspected bandits.
