SEARS ROEBUCK TO HELP FARMER SELL PRODUCTS

CHICAGO, Nov. 22.—The establishment of a Sears Roebuck agricultural research foundation, set up for the purpose of determining essential facts relating to the farming industry was announced today by Julius Rosenwald, president of the Sears Roebuck company.

He declared the foundation will be headed by the most capable men to be found in the agricultural research field. A field force is also said to be contemplated with headquarters in Chicago. The announcement sets out that every phase of the agricultural economics is to be studied.

"As businessmen," Mr. Rosenwald said, "we feel under a direct obligation to do everything we can to improve the farmers' condition. A survey has revealed to us that where the farmer needs help is in economics in marketing his products."

"The American farmer stands today as the most efficient farmer in the world. On production per man he has no equal. His problem at the present time is the disposal of the surplus which he has piled up thru better farming methods, and it is essential that he reap the full reward for the use of these improved methods."

RUSHING FOOTBALL PICTURES TO PAPER TRAFFIC VIOLATION

OLYMPIA, Wash., Nov. 22.—Violation of traffic laws to make speed records on the state highway, will not be permitted, L. D. McArdle, director of the department of efficiency has announced.

"Any person attempting to break speed records in violation of state laws will be arrested, just as anyone else violating the law," Mr. McArdle said.

Efforts will be made, Mr. McArdle intimated, to get the legislature to pass a law making the advertising of a record run in violation of the speed limit, prima facie evidence of reckless driving. Such a law already operates in a number of states, Mr. McArdle said.

A news article appearing in a Seattle paper telling of the delivery of football pictures from Berkeley, Cal., to Seattle in approximately 25 hours would come under this head, Mr. McArdle continued. To make the run an average speed of more than 35 miles would be required, he pointed out, and that through cities where the speed limit was 20 miles an hour and not allowing for any stops on the road. Mr. McArdle said he would take up the matter with the newspaper.

German Ship Is Blown Up By Baltic Mine

LONDON, Nov. 22.—The steamer Kronos, bound from Stettin, Germany to Petrograd has been sunk off the island of Gotland in the Baltic and seventeen bodies have been washed ashore, according to a news agency dispatch from Helsingfors today. Some of the bodies were badly mutilated from which the deduction was drawn that the steamer was blown up by a mine.

The Kronos was a German steamer of 929 tons gross, built in 1897. Stettin was her port of registry.

WET CANADIAN OFFICIAL DENIES BORDER SCANDAL

OTTAWA, Ont., Nov. 22.—Minister of Customs Jacques Bureau issued a statement on his return today from the west challenging newspapers in Ontario to "show where the federal department of customs has failed to do all in its power to co-operate with the United States officials in preventing illicit shipments of liquor entering the United States from Canada."

The challenge was in reply to attacks on his department that appeared in a Toronto newspaper regarding a recent interview given by the minister in Regina.

"While I do not believe in prohibition, I want it clearly understood that customs officers along the international border have been instructed to go further than might be reasonably expected in their efforts to see that the laws of a friendly nation are not violated," his statement said in part.

MISSING EVERETT MAN IS FOUND

EVERETT, Wash., Nov. 21.—Lester Koontz, an employee of the Healy-Hartley Box company of Robe, was found last night in the mountains north of here by searching parties after wandering for two days. When Koontz failed to return from a prospecting trip in the hills Sunday searching parties were organized. Koontz was suffering from exposure and hunger as he was without a coat or food for the entire time. Physicians stated he would recover.

Convict Murderer Is Found Guilty; Must Hang December 28

WALLA WALLA, Wash., Nov. 22.—Motion for new trial in the case of Thomas Walton, the convict who was recently found guilty of murdering two of his fellow prisoners in the state penitentiary, by a superior court jury, was denied by Judge E. C. Mills today and the slayer was sentenced to hang on December 28. Convict friends of Walton had raised a fund for his defense in the new trial, had it been granted. Several of them were introduced as witnesses at the recent trial, but their testimony which consisted of statements to the effect that Walton's victims had previously threatened to kill him was thrown out by court ruling.
